Regulations for the "IAA AMBASSADOR/AMBASADOR MSB" distinction

The purpose of the "IAA AMBASSADOR/AMBASADOR MSB" distinction is to honour natural persons who are business and gallery owners, artists, scientists, representatives of: local governments, business organisations, cultural institutions, trade fair organisers, non-governmental organisations, etc., who actively promote the activities of the International Amber Association in their country of residence or operation and, in the opinion of the IAA Board, deserve exceptional recognition.

The Rules of Procedure establish the principles and procedures for awarding the "IAA AMBASSADOR/AMBASADOR MSB" distinction.

§1 General provisions

The distinction is presented by the Board of Directors of the International Amber Association.

§2 Principles for awarding distinctions

1. The person awarded with the "IAA AMBASSADOR/AMBASADOR MSB" distinction is expected to diligently represent and promote the International Amber Association in their country of residence or country of business. The distinction aims to strengthen the IAA's position in a particular region of the world.
2. The person awarded with the "IAA AMBASSADOR/AMBASADOR MSB" distinction may use the specially prepared logotype (appendix 1) in the following situations: on their business website, on leaflets promoting the activity and on business cards. In the materials specified above, a person may include the logo (appendix 1) together with a description of the distinction sent by the IAA office. If the logo is placed on other materials, the IAA Board may request that the logo be removed.
3. The person awarded with the "IAA AMBASSADOR/AMBASADOR MSB" receives from the IAA office a set of leaflets and other materials necessary for the promotion of the IAA.
4. The distinction is acknowledged with a commemorative diploma made by the IAA.
5. The IAA will present the awardee in the "Bursztynisko. The Amber Magazine" magazine, and on the website at www.amber.org.pl, under a dedicated tab: "IAA AMBASSADOR/ AMBASADOR MSB".
6. Documentation related to the process of awarding distinctions and their register is maintained by the IAA Board.
7. The IAA Board oversees compliance with the rules on decorations.

§3 Revocation of the distinction

1. Revocation of a distinction may occur in the following cases:

(a) the distinction was awarded as a result of a misrepresentation,

(b) the awardee has committed an act that renders them unworthy of the distinction.

2. The Commission shall inform the awardee in writing, against acknowledgement of receipt, of its decision to revoke the statuette and commemorative diploma.
3. The awardee has the right to appeal against the decision to revoke the distinction within 14 days from the date of delivery of the letter.
4. The appeal shall be considered by the IAA Board with the final decision resting with the President of the Association.
5. The decisions following the appeal are final and effective from the date of the decision.
6. If the distinction is revoked, the IAA President/Board shall request the awardee to return the statuette and commemorative diploma.
7. The data of the awardee entered in the Register of Honours shall be deleted from the register with a note of the date and reasons for revoking the distinction.
8. The IAA Board oversees compliance with the rules on distinctions.

These Rules of Procedure enter into force on the date of their adoption by the General Meeting - 20.06.2024
